- Most indicated time or transportation are barriers to being involved at the school. (Do we need to find other times to hold events?)
- Specific questions to address:
 - The school regularly communicates with me about academic and behavior expectations and my child's academic progress.
 - During my most recent parent-teacher conference, the teacher provided test data, student work samples, and examples of grade level work, and explained them in a way that helped me understand my child's progress.
 - The days and times available for my last parent-teacher conference worked well for me.
 - What barriers, if any, prevent you from being as involved in your child's education as you would like to be?
