	 Catalina admin and Bond committee meet every Wednesday morning for updates.
	 We have scheduled 8th grade visits to Catalina as we promote our E-Sports program. We continue to struggle with attendance, as such our front office staff has been sending attendance letters often and we are working with dropout to make home visits to chronically absent students.
	Budget:
	 Our Title I Budget was reduced again this year by \$35,000. In the last 4 years we have consistently lost \$35,000+ in Title I. We use our Title I to fund personnel. (Dean of Students, CSP, Counselor, Student Intervention Specialist) We will have to make tough decisions in the next few days to compensate for the reduction in budget allocation. Last year finance made a mistake in our favor and they owned it and funded us a counselor, but this year we will have to fund a counselor from the Title I that is already reduced. In M&O we have been reduced by 3.6FTE. Our 25-26 Master schedule reflects the reduction
