REPORTS TO REVIEW	Principal
DISCUSSION	 General: Walk-thru with the state went well and they gave good feedback that was shared with the staff. Catalina was used for the Wednesday PLD and we had over 600 people on campus. We are still waiting for the district to reimburse us for the supplies that were used for that event. Still working on how the TV monitors can be fixed for announcements. Board member Jennifer Ekstrom came to campus on 11/18. She took a tour and was

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	very concerned with the safety/lack or security on campus, especially at the entrances. She will address it with the Superintendent.
	Budget: The school was notified that we will have budget cuts for next year. All Title I budgets will have a 6-27% cut. We are waiting to find our how much ours will be. Our Title I budget primarily funds staff.
	Personnel: Catalina hired a new Athletic Coordinator – Chelsea Duran. She was the admin assistant for athletics. The parents noted that they are very happy. We have a new PT custodian starting.
	There is now a vacancy for an Admin Assistant.
	 Events: There was a Parent Cafecito today and one parent attended to discuss the Letter Grade.

They are having to pick up grass by hand and its leaving the fields uneven. It also makes it difficult to properly feed and seed the fields. The new grass catcher will cost around \$5500 The team has many questions: Where will they dispose of the grass clippings? – They go in a special bin for green debris and it is composted Who empties the grass catcher? – Grounds team is trained and responsible for emptying How do we guarantee it won't be stolen or disappear to another site? – We have a secure field house and trust it will not be an issue. How old is the mower is will be connected to? What is that mower's life-span? – The mower will not be replaced if it breaks down, It will most likely be repaired.
