## **Brainbook Education Course**

The Arizona Interscholastic Association has passed legislation that impacts the entire state. ARS 15-341 (24) (SB 1521) mandates that schools follow the AIA's policies/directions to provide concussion education information to students, parents and coaches. BYLAW 14.13: Concussion Education – **All students** shall complete the Brainbook Online Concussion Education Course. **All students** shall complete the course **prior** to participation in practice or competition. Returning students from Catalina that have already completed the course are **exempt**. Transfer students that took the course must provide a "Certificate of Completion."

Directions for logging onto the Brainbook Online Concussion Education Course:

1. Type **aiainline.org** into your search engine
2. Click on AIA Academy
  - a. Academy Quick links
  - b. Click on Concussion Education Brainbook
  - c. Login – click on: "Register as Student"
  - d. Follow directions (fill in information to continue to register)
  - e. To view videos, you may have to download "Adobe Flash"
3. Students need to score **80%** on the course in order to **pass**. Upon completion of the **50 minute** course, print the "**Certificate of Completion**" (save a copy). The certificate must be turned in with the completed sports packet.
4. The Brainbook Course only needs to be completed once.
